

Mysolation Mystery Quilt

Using Layer Cakes or 10" squares

This will work for Option 1, Scrappy.

I have had a few enquiries about using Layer Cakes for your requirements, this can work really well as you get a large variety of fabrics with very little left over.

Fabric Options

1. Two Layer Cakes (84 x 10" squares)
2. One Layer Cakes (42 x 10" squares) plus approx. 2.5m assorted fabrics

Cutting for Two Layer Cakes

This will give you the exact amounts for all pieces except the 2 ½" squares, you will have **16 extra**, you may like to cut a few extras of everything

From **Thirty Two** assorted Layer Cake squares cut thirty two 8" x 8' squares

From **Thirty Two** Layer Cake squares use **Diagram 1**

From **Sixteen** Layer Cake squares use **Diagram 2**

You will have in total

- Thirty two 8" x 8" squares
- One hundred and ninety two - 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares
- Sixty four - 2 ½" x 6 ½" pieces
- Eighty - 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares (**this is 16 more than you need**)

Cutting for One Layer Cake plus extra assorted fabrics

This will give you the exact amounts you may like to cut a few extras of everything

From **Twenty** Layer Cake squares cut

- Twenty 8" x 8" squares

From the remaining **Twenty two** Layer Cake squares use the **cutting Diagram 2** to cut

- Eighty eight - 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares
- Forty four - 2 ½" x 6 ½" pieces
- Twenty two - 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

From the assorted extra fabrics you will need to cut and extra

- Twelve 8" x 8" squares
- One hundred and four - 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares
- Twenty - 2 ½" x 6 ½" pieces
- Forty two - 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

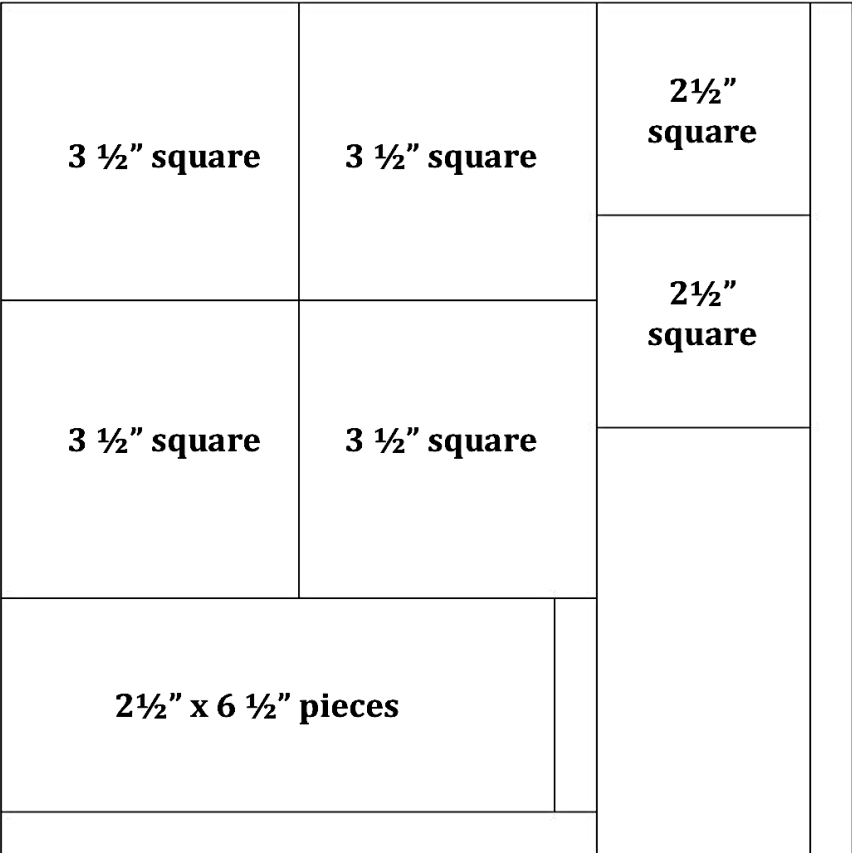
