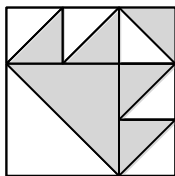


It's time to **Pick-a-Box** !

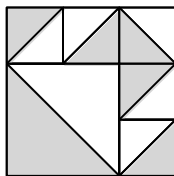
This will give a pattern for putting the half square triangle units into a block. (At a workshop when we don't have to obey 'social-distancing', there would actually be 5 unlabelled boxes, hence PICK-A-BOX ! But here you can see all 5 blocks.)

Make your choice, choosing just one, making all the blocks the same.

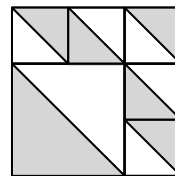

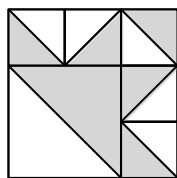

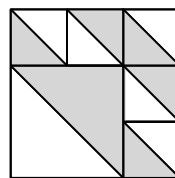

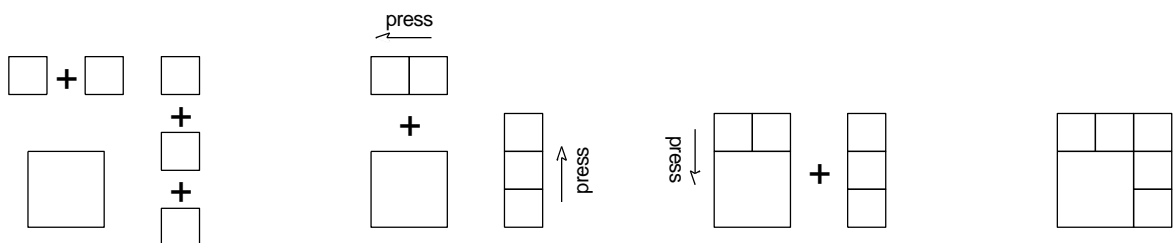

Stitch 5 small half square triangle units to one large half square triangle unit following the pattern chosen and the method below . (8" block)

The sequence of piecing and pressing is as follows. This time press in the direction of the arrows. As there is still another box to pick, it would be best not to press the last seam after adding the group of three until next week.



You may wish to keep the fabric consistent in each block ie the same two fabrics. For a “scrappier” look, you may prefer to mix the fabrics.

Complete the 64 blocks for large quilt - 36 blocks for the smaller size quilt.
