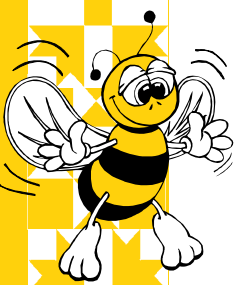

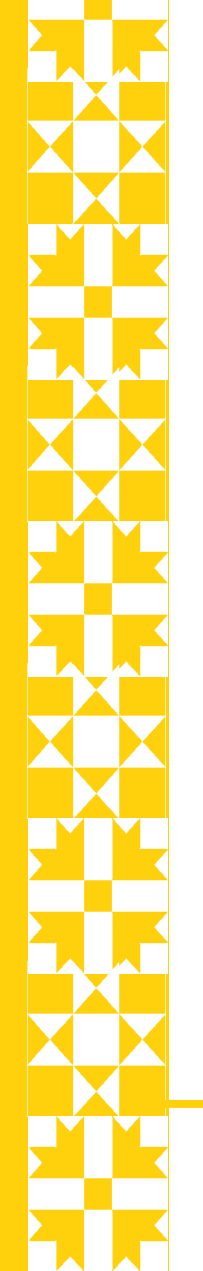

Why we need your help

One in two Australians will be diagnosed with cancer by the age of 85. Each year almost 95,000 new cases of cancer are diagnosed.

While the survival rates for many common cancers has increased by more than 30 per cent in the past two decades, cancer is still the leading cause of death in Australia—around 38,000 Australians die from cancer each year.
