**WHAT'S NEW in 2018?**

- **Quilt categories** have been revised (for more detail, please see the required features of each category on Page 2).
  - Major categories are based on technique: Pieced, Appliqué, Combined Pieced and Appliqué, and Other Techniques
  - Miniatures will now be entered according to technique.
  - Two-person and Group entries are now Collaborative, with three technique-based categories available.
  - Other Techniques, Art/Innovative and Pictorial entries can be collaborative works.
  - Junior A and Junior B have been combined in a single Junior category.
  - The new flow chart can be used to help you select the appropriate category for your entry.
- **Excellence in Machine Quilting – Frame Mounted Award:** this Special Award will be presented to the **quilter**, regardless of who made the quilt top or entered the quilt.
- **Art to Wear:** for 2018 only, the photograph required for up-loading is of the **original** article, before modification.
- **Drop off locations:** quilts will be accepted only at the designated locations, at the designated times. No alternative delivery arrangements can be made with Festival of Quilts Committee members (see Online Entry Form Guidelines – Quilt Delivery Dates on Page 3).

## ONLINE ENTRY FORM GUIDELINES

- All entries must be submitted via the online process. If this is a challenging prospect for you, please consider asking someone in your family or local quilting group to enter the data for you, or perhaps your local council librarian.
- The on-line entry form is to be completed in accordance with the separate Conditions of Entry, Status Definitions and Categories information.
- A separate entry form is required for each quilt/item entered unless it is a linked pair or triptych. A maximum number of 5 entries per member includes Display Only and Art to Wear entries.

### Paying for your entry

- The entry fee is \$15 per entry (non refundable). This must be paid prior to completing your online entry and the receipt number noted. Payments may be made by direct deposit or at monthly Guild meetings. There is no entry fee for Junior entrants.

### Information you will need to have ready in order to complete your online entry form:

- Your contact details, including email address
- Your membership number or the membership number of your affiliated group
- For Junior entrants, name and membership number of their sponsor (a financial member of the Guild)
- For Collaborative entries, details of the other entrant(s): name, membership number
- The category of your entry: these have changed, so refer to the flow chart and Table of Categories to make the most appropriate selection
- Specific details of the entry: the title of the entry and measurements in centimetres (for quilts)
- The insurance value of your entry
- Payment details: reference number, receipt number from your financial institution, date of transaction
- Technical information: your design source, copyright permissions/acknowledgements, techniques and materials used
- Personal narrative: a 40-50 word statement of interest to viewers, such as the purpose of this quilt, personal connections, choices/decisions made, particular challenges it presented
- A digital image of up to 5MB of your entry to be uploaded during the online entry process. For **Art to Wear**, the image must be of the article in its original state, *before* upcycling.

### After you have submitted your online entry form:

- An automatic acknowledgment email will be sent shortly after the submit button is entered. If you do not receive this email please check your junk mail folder before contacting foqentries@gmail.com
- A record of all of the information you entered in the online form will be sent to you in a separate email; check this carefully for correctness
- Changes can be made to our database if you need to modify information submitted on your entry form. Email foqentries@gmail.com. Do not re-enter the item as a new entry.
- Details of drop off points and post-show quilt collection are included in your acknowledgement email.

**CLOSING DATE FOR ONLINE ENTRIES:** **FRIDAY, 1 June 2018.**  
No late entries will be accepted.

**QUILT DELIVERY DATES:** at the Guild meeting, **THURSDAY, 7 June 2018,**  
at the Royal Adelaide Showgrounds, **MONDAY, 2 July 2018**  
**between 10am and 2pm**
