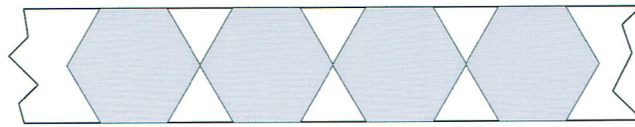
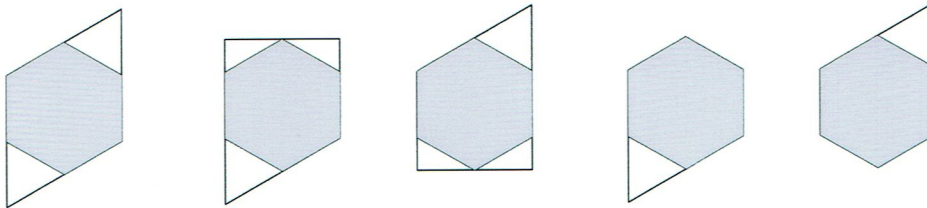


**HEXAGON QUILT using hexagon template.**

From the hexagon fabric cut a 3½" strip. One strip yields 10 hexagons. Alternate rows start and finish with a half hexagon. To allow for seams, use a whole hexagon and after the rows are sewn together trim top and bottom of quilt.



The rows are sewn together with background triangles as shown below and finished with half triangles top and bottom. The background triangles are cut from a strip 2¼" wide. One strip yields 28.



Make as many rows and hexagons in a row required for the size quilt you would like.

Print this at actual size (100%) to ensure templates are accurate
