They were assembled into an art quilt drawing inspiration from the flight of the Monarch butterfly...hundreds of butterflies flying from many places and finally nestling together in comfort and support.

It was made of nearly 700 donated tiles. The date lettering was done by Sue of Sue's Sewing World. The small tile on top right of the heart was made by the daughter of Jean Pearce (LQoL founder) Erica Diment.

The Tile project was designed and put together by Wendy Heap, the current LQoL co-ordinator and with the enormous help of Roz Heaft.

The finished product has been donated to the Women's and Children's hospital Foundation & will be on display at Festival of Quilts 2017.
