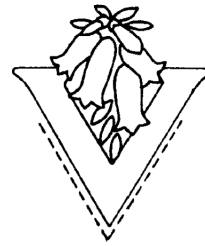


*“The Fabric of
Society”*
Quilt Challenge
2011



The challenge is to make a quilt that is inspired by, recreated from, or adapted from any quilt as published in the book *“The Fabric of Society – Australian Quilt Heritage from the Convict Times to 1960”* by Dr. Annette Gero, Quilt Historian.

It is expected that the quilt maker will make the quilt in the spirit and tradition of the original and be the work of one person.

This will be a juried and judged competition, open to any resident Australian quilter. Entries are invited by 1st May 2011 to be on show at the Victorian Quilters Inc Quilt Showcase Exhibition in Melbourne in July 2011. Conditions of Entry & Entry forms will be available for downloading from the Victorian Quilters Inc website from 1st December 2009.

The two (2) categories will be:

“Quilts” consisting of 3 layers and visibly quilted through the 3 layers.

“Coverlets/Waggas” may be 3 layers or as the original quilt of 2 layers with no batting, with or without quilting or tied.

It may be a part of a quilt or the whole quilt with a minimum size of 100cms x 100cms and a maximum size of 290cms x 290cms.

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
