

24 Constellation of Dresdens with Heather Ford - Sun 16

Size: 150 x 150 cms (60" x 60")

Have fun playing with the Dresden plate block. In this workshop, you will make several different styles of plates. They are all very easy to make, but look quite complicated. You will learn how to make all the different plates shown in the sample quilt. As some of the cutting techniques are repeated, we will cover all the techniques and then you can go back and make the repeats. You will probably not get all the plates constructed in the workshop but will be able to finish them later. The workshop sample quilt measures approx. 60" x 60". Basic cutting and machine piecing skills required. Purchase of the Matilda's Own Dresden Ruler Set is also required.



25 Sewing Box with Sue Megaw – Sun 16

Size: 23 cm x 15 cm x 13 cm approximately (9" x 6" x 5")

This sewing box is based on designs seen when travelling in Japan. Use traditional Japanese or modern fabrics to create a unique sewing container to carry your small projects to class, stitching group or holiday. A great opportunity to use a range of coordinating fabrics in one project. You will learn bag making skills including machine quilting, working with bias, inserting zippers using easy hand stitching (similar to traditional Japanese methods), options for decorative applique (including decorative applique and sashiko stitching). Patterns provided for a matching scissor keeper and needle case complete the set. Some easy pre-class preparation (with detailed instructions) is required. This class is suitable for those who have some hand sewing and machining experience.

26 Geese on the Table with Wendy Nutt - Sun 16

Size – 56cms x 56cms (22" x 22")

This small project can be adapted to make many more complex designs. Geese on The Table is a great introduction to 'freezer paper' foundation paper piecing. In this class you will be shown how to draught your own pattern and learn the basics of foundation paper piecing using the 'freezer paper' technique. This is a great way of achieving perfect accuracy with your points. The class also includes the technique of sewing incomplete seams. We'll have time in this class to complete the table topper. Wendy will show you some other ideas for using your pieced quilt top. This is complete with machine stitching and is suitable for all skill levels.
