41 Hot Chillies with Wendy Nutt – Wed 19

Size: 95 cm x 95 cm (46" x 46")

Throw the rules out the window; there's no quilt police in this class. This could easily be the most fun you've ever had cutting and sewing a quilt together. If you've wanted to try Improvisational cutting and piecing, here is your opportunity. With some guidance from Wendy on how to cut without rulers and a bit of practice, you will be machine piecing quilt tops together in a day. Wendy will show you a few assembly tricks that will guarantee a perfectly flat quilt top. You'll be able to create your own quilt recipe to make unique 'one of a kind' quilts. You should be able to complete a small quilt top in this class.

Suitable for all skill levels.

42 Duffle Bag with Rachelle Denny – Thurs 20

Size: 24 cm x 24 cm x 24 cm (9½" x 9½" x 16½")
The pattern for this duffle bag is from the book by Tyla Oates; you will be required to purchase the book for the class (available for \$30). The book contains patterns for three different sizes with two different styles. We will be making the medium size bag with a choice of straight or curved ends. It is a fabulous and versatile bag with many uses; great for a project bag or for a weekend away. Lots of fun and I guarantee you will want to make more. Basic machine sewing skills required.



43 Kites in the Park with Wendy Nutt – Thurs 20

Size: 45 cm x 45 cm (18" x 18")

This workshop will introduce you to 'freezer paper' foundation paper piecing. This technique eliminates the tedious time consuming method of old, where paper has to be torn away from the work. The paper is folded out of the way when sewing and once the design is complete, the paper is peeled away. This technique is extremely accurate and can be used in place of traditional foundation paper piecing. Wendy will also show you how to obtain perfectly sewn curves. There will be enough time in class to complete the cushion front and possibly some of the quilting.

Skill level – beginner to advanced, however, machine piecing skills will be helpful.
