Accommodation and catering at Immanuel College

The college is conveniently located only four kilometres from Adelaide Airport and eight kilometres from the Adelaide CBD. There are single rooms in the Boarding House and all bathroom facilities are shared in this building. There will be a reduction in the cost for participants allocated to the Boarding House. The Boarding House is on two levels, **so please indicate clearly on the registration form if you require ground floor accommodation**. The remainder of the accommodation is available in units and houses that accommodate 4 to 8 people, each in single rooms, with a shared living room, kitchen and bathroom. There are a few steps at the entrance to each of these units. Bed linen, pillow, towel and doona with cover are provided for each person. You might like to bring an extra blanket or quilt along with your own pillow. If you would like to stay an extra night please make the request on the registration form.

In allocating accommodation priority is given to the preferences of participants staying the full 6 days.

Full catering is included from dinner on the night of registration through to afternoon tea on the last day of your package. Special dietary requirements can be catered for – please indicate your needs clearly on the registration form. Please be aware that **the entire Immanuel College Campus is a non-smoking area**.

Sewing Machines

For participants **unable to bring their own**, a **limited** number of sewing machines are generously made available from one of our major sponsors, **Otto and Penny's Sewing Centre** at Walkerville. **Please indicate on the registration form if you will need a loan machine**. Otto, along with your ever helpful committee members, will be available after workshops some days for advice, or to perhaps assist with the purchase of a new Bernina! The use of a loan machine with which you may be unfamiliar may not give the expected result. On Friday night, 13 July, there will be a short tutorial to introduce you to the loan machine and its basic functions.
