

4 *Cherish* with Jodi Godfrey

Sat 14 / Sun 15

Size – 158 cm x 160 cm or 63" x 64"



The *Cherish* quilt was designed to show off your best fabrics and to enjoy hand-stitching them at a relaxed pace. In this class, Jodi will teach you about the different kinds of prints in a collection and how best to use them to make a quilt you'll treasure and enjoy. Leading patterns and supporting prints, colour and value, contrast and layout will be discussed in class so that you can approach your cherished quilts with confidence. All English Paper Piecing basics will be covered, so no previous experience is necessary. A starter pack can be purchased at a cost of approx. \$45 (including acrylic templates) before the class. All papers and acrylic templates are laser cut to order in our studio in Castlemaine, Vic. Suitable for all skill levels.

5 *Shadow Trapunto* with Heather Hopkins

Sat 14 / Sun 15

Size – approximately 50 cm square or 19.5"

This stunning little gem will teach you trapunto techniques. You will take it to the next level by adding another element in your shadow which is colour then finally some stunning free motion fillers giving your quilt layered interest and high impact. Knowledge of free motion quilting is essential but this class is suitable and adjustable for all skill levels. Heather can supply a kit containing all the required fabrics and battings for this class at a cost of \$28.00.



6 *Woodland Flora* with Jacqui Karl

Sat 14 / Sun 15

Size – 56 cm x 33 cm approximately 22" x 13"

A simple quilted background with cut out 'holes' that are stitched and embellished, to give a great textured look to this work. Adorned with flowers and leaves using a couple of different techniques, this little wall hanging is a true textile art piece. Suitable for all skill levels. Jacqui says you will complete or get very close to finishing the project in two days.

7 *Bouquet of Daisies* with Michelle Marvig

Sat 14 / Sun 15

Size – 152 cm or 60" square

Block size: 38 cm or 15" square

Pieced, modern daisies bloom in this quilt design. The daisies are cut with acrylic templates (cost approx. \$35.00) and sensational effects can be achieved by fussy cutting your prints. "Y" seams are required to piece this block and techniques will be shown to give a flat finish to these seams. The centre octagons will be hand stitched in place. The daisies float on a variety of grey frames and you can "audition" these fabrics before you cut and piece them in the design, as the main daisies can be stitched independently of the darker grey fabrics. There are many design possibilities with this template set; simply change the number of fabrics used and the placement of the values. Suitable for all levels.
