

8 *Sashiko Wreath* with Jane MacDonald

Sat 14 / Sun 15



Size – 35 cm square **or** 14” square

Australian Bush Colours Wreath: the sashiko techniques that will be covered include how to transfer designs onto the fabric and how to achieve the “grain of rice” stitches following simple principles. This stitched design works perfectly either framed, as a cushion, wall-hanging or the beginning of a quilt. Suitable for all levels.

9 *Retreat Bag* with Monica Poole

The Retreat Bag is a big roomy bag that’s perfect for a weekend getaway. It features an eye-catching shape with a secure zipper top closure. The bag unzips nice and wide to reveal an internal zipper pocket as well as slip pockets to keep your belongings organised. Monica will teach you lots of great bag making techniques in this workshop. Suitable for beginners with some machine sewing experience. A full kit, including the heavier weight linen/cotton blend fabric, is available for \$120.



10 *Brunswick Star* or *Charity Wheel* with Chris Serong

Mon 16 / Tues 17

Size – Brunswick Star: 158 cms **or** 62” square Charity Wheel: 140 cms **or** 55” square



A choice of two designs is offered in this workshop, both using Chris’s method with freezer paper for foundation piecing. There is no stitching through the paper which can be peeled off when the stitching is complete. This method is extremely accurate and can be applied whenever traditional paper piecing is used. In this class the students can make a sample of *Charity Wheels* on day one and then a sample of the *Brunswick Star* on day



two if they wish. Both these patterns will be complimentary to students in this class.

The Brunswick Star quilt is more suited to an Intermediate level quilter while the Charity Wheels quilt is suitable for beginners.

11 *Mystery Quilt – Double the Fun* with Rachelle Denny

Wed 18 / Thurs 19

Size – 182 cm square **or** 72” square

This year’s *Mystery Quilt* will give you double the fun: two days of sewing a fantastic new Modern design. Let’s curve it up on the straight and narrow using a selection of your favourite fabrics, together with two contrasting background fabrics. The finished quilt is 182 cm or 72” square but you will have multiple options to increase the size with either a plain border making it 208 cm or 82” square, or a more complex pieced border increasing the size to 229 cm or 90” plus. More details will be included in your requirements list. An acrylic ruler will be an optional extra for purchase - approx. \$15. Suitable for confident beginner and up.
