

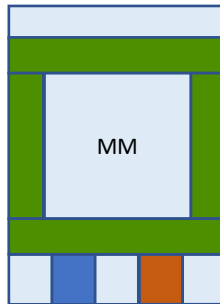
QGSA ROUND THE BLOCK MYSTERY QUILT 2020

50" x 50"

Press as you go, pressing towards your darker fabrics. Make sure that your seams are completely flat on the right side.

LET'S GET THIS QUILT PUT TOGETHER!! (WEEK THREE)

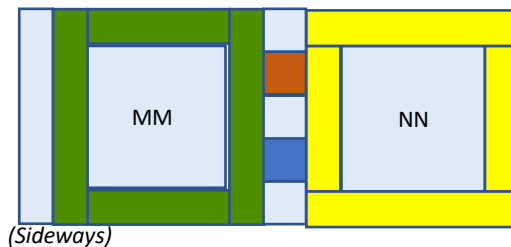
1. Add a 2 ½" x 10 ½" background rectangle to the top of your UNIT MM.



- Add this group of 2 ½" squares to the bottom:



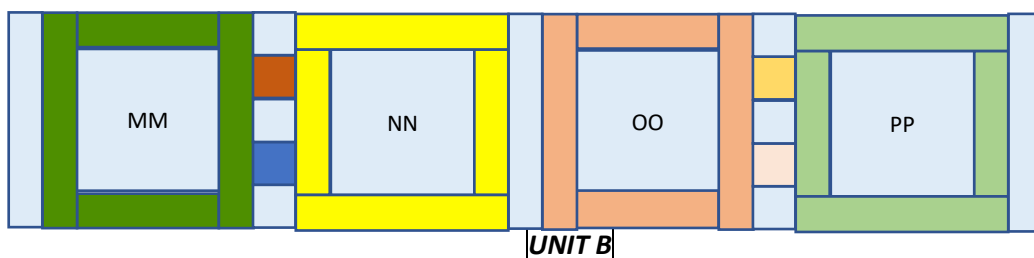
- Below this, add UNIT NN.



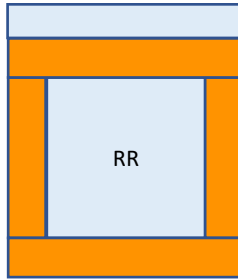
- Below this, add a 2 ½" x 10 ½" **background** strip.
- Below this, add your UNIT OO.
- Add this strip of 2 ½" squares next:



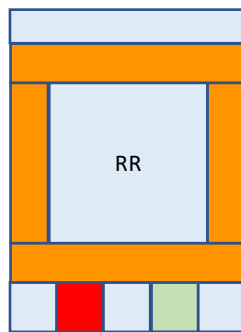
- Add UNIT PP next.
- Finally, add your remaining 2 ½" x 10 ½" **background** strip to produce **UNIT B**



2. Add a $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ background rectangle to the top of your UNIT RR.



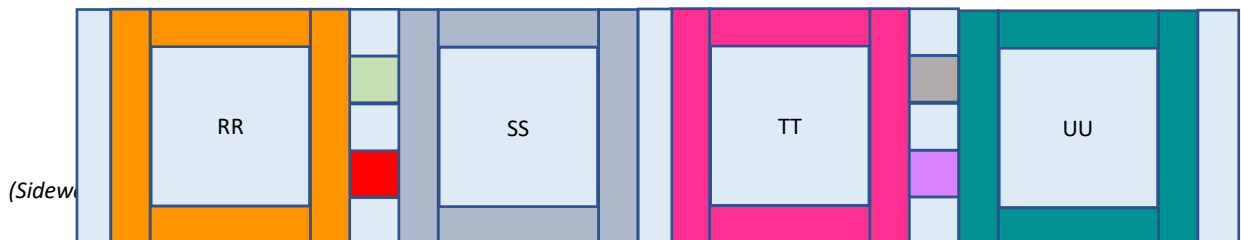
- Add this group of $2\frac{1}{2}''$ squares to the bottom:



- Below this, add your UNIT SS
- Below this, add a $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ **background** strip.
- Below this, add UNIT TT.
- Add this group of $2\frac{1}{2}''$ squares next:



- Add UNIT UU below.
- Finally, add your last $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ **background** strip. You have now constructed **UNIT D**



3. Assemble your quilt top as shown on the following page:

- Sew UNIT A to UNIT B
- Add UNIT C
- Add UNIT D
- Add UNIT E

- To each side of your quilt top add a 2 ½" x 50 ½" **background** strip (check your side and centre measurements first (should all be 50 ½")) and trim your strip to that measurement.
