SHOP HOP 2019 HOW IT RUNS

WHEN - Timeframe of 3 months – August 1st through to 31st October 2019

WHO - Individual Guild members, affiliated members, members of affiliated groups, our participating Merchant Shops

WHERE - Participating shops will be both country and city Guild member shops.

HOW - This is a shop hop for individuals or take a trip with a car load of friends. Hire a bus and do a day trip or make a holiday of it and trip around the state like Faye P.! To participate, hoppers will collect a free passport from:

1. The July or August Guild meetings
2. Download a passport from the Guild website
3. SA Guilds Workshop Newsletter
4. July 31st I-Patch newsletter
5. Photocopy the passport that will be published in the August Patches magazine.

- There will be a box on the front of the passport to record hopper's name, phone number, membership number or group number (affiliated members)
- All participating merchant details will be included on the passport.
- Spend a minimum of \$10-00 at each shop visited to receive a stamp in the passport, signed and dated by team at the store.
- Should hoppers fill a passport they can start a second passport.

- At the end of the hop participants will send their stamped passports to the Event co-ordinator Lisa Robson-Thoo for collating. These can be posted to Lisa Robson-Thoo, PO Box 993, Kent Town, 5071 or scanned and emailed to saquilters.workshops@gmail.com
All passports are to be returned by Thursday November 14.

- Winners will be the person with the most stamps in their passport. Two prize baskets will be awarded at the December Guild meeting - one country winner, one city winner. If there are no clear winners those who visit the most shops will go in a draw to find the winner. The baskets will be on display at the August meeting and will be full of quilting goodies.

- Each merchant will have 1 free pattern for a quilt block to be given to each hopper. The theme for the shop hop is "Stars". Merchants can choose to cut kits for their block, to be sold to hoppers, should they wish.

- Hoppers are asked to make a quilt from the blocks they collect and there will be a display of the finished quilts at Festival of Quilts 2020. Quilts can be donated to charity should they wish, either by the hopper or the Guild.
