## MONTH TWO - BLOCK 7 - March

This block is called OLD TIPPECANOE and is $8^{\prime \prime}$ square finished. Another block made with half square triangles, see "getting started" for how to make half square triangles if you need to.

## Fabric requirements for this block

Three fabrics required, , they could have been a background and two others, I chose three fabrics which contrast well with each other

- Fabric A pale green
- Fabric B is red print
- Fabric C is gold with text


## Cutting

- A - pale green - cut $8 \times 31 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares

- B - red print - cut $4 \times 3 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares
- C - gold with text - cut $4 \times 3 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares


## Construction

- Lay one A square and one $B$ square right sides together and make two $\times 21 / 2 \prime$ half squares triangles. Repeat three more times $=8$ half square triangles
- Lay one A square and one C square right sides together and make two $\times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ half square triangles. Repeat three more times $=8$ half square triangles
- Lay them out as in the photo above and construct rows then join the rows to form the block

The block is now complete and will measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square which will be 8 " square finished.
