

MONTH FOUR– BLOCK 15 - May

This block is called *CROSS ROADS* and is 4" square finished.

Fabric requirements for this block

Two fabrics are required. I chose green floral and green spot

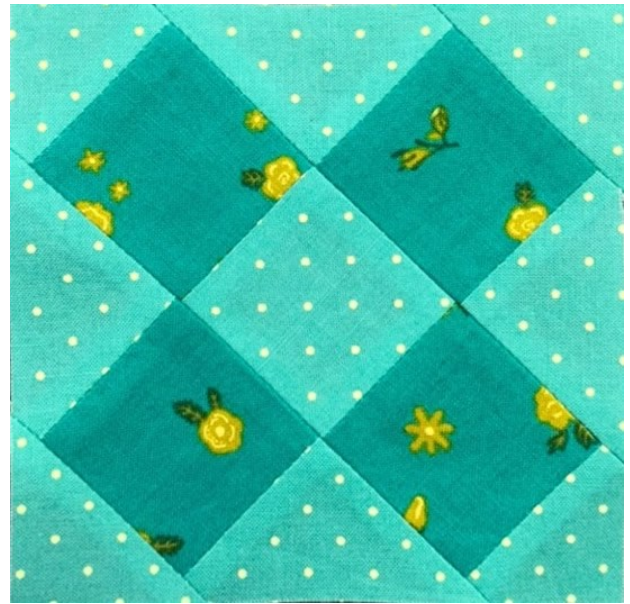
- A, C & D are green spot
- B is green floral

Cutting

- A – green spot – cut 2 x 1 7/8th squares, cross cut corner to corner, once = 4 triangles
- B – green floral – cut 4 x 2" squares
- C – green spot – cut 1 x 3 1/4" square, cross cut corner to corner, twice = 4 triangles
- D – green spot – cut 1 x 2" square

Construction

- Lay the A, B, C and D elements out as shown on the right
- Lay a C green spot triangle right sides together with a B green floral square, matching the 90° corners, the C triangle will extend beyond the edge of the B square at each end as shown below, stitch and press, see below (left). Repeat the process to add a second C green spot triangle to the opposite side of the B green floral square as shown below (right).



- Repeat the above process with the opposite B green floral square and two C green spot triangles as shown on the right



- Join the three centre 2" squares together to form a row and then add the B/C units to either side as shown on the right. Then add the A green spot triangles to each corner of the block. Finger press to find the centre of the long side of A and the edge of the B squares so you can align them perfectly



The block is now complete and measures 4½" square which will be 4" square finished.
