## MONTH FOUR- BLOCK 16 - May

This block is called RIGHT AND LEFT and is 4" square finished.

## Fabric requirements for this block

This block needs two fabrics, I chose light blue and blue print

- A \& C are light blue
- $B$ is blue pattern


## Cutting

- A - light blue - cut $1 \times 31 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " square, cross cut corner to corner, twice $=4$ triangles

- B - blue pattern - cut $1 \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square, cross cut corner to corner, twice $=4$ triangles
- C - light blue - cut $1 \times 33 / 8^{\text {th" }}$ square


## Construction

- Lay one A light blue triangle right sides together on top of one B blue pattern triangle, matching all the sides. Stitch together with the light blue triangle on top, starting from the $90^{\circ}$ corner. Repeat with the other three $A$ and $B$ triangles. Press then lay them out as shown on the right.

- Find the middle of one side of the C light blue square and finger press a fold. Line up the $90^{\circ}$ join of the $A / B$ unit at that point. Repeat with the opposite side of $C$ and stitch these elements together. Repeat with the other two sides of $C$ and the remaining two $A / B$ units
- As always don't forget to trim the "ears" from the block


The block is now complete and measures $41 / 2 \prime$ " square which will be $4 "$ square finished.
