
## **CLAYTON'S JEWEL BOX QUILT**

A scrap quilt using just two units, a half square triangle and a four patch. It works well as a scrap quilt with many different fabrics in multi colours or lots of scraps in one colour, ie blue like in the photo.


The kit contains


72 x 5" squares in both background and contrast fabric


To make half square triangle units use 36 background and contrast squares. First draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the background fabric. Place a contrast and background square right sides together and sew a ¼" seam on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press to the dark. Trim to 4½". See diagram below.



To make the four-patch unit use 36 background and contrast squares. Place a background and contrast fabric right sides together and sew a ¼" seam on opposite sides of the square. Cut the unit in half so each piece measures 2½" x 5", see diagrams below. Press to the dark. Cut each of these in half and sew back together for a four patch. See diagrams below. Unit measures 4½"










