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CLAYTON'S SCRAP QUILT HELEN/KAY 48" square

Another quilt to use up scraps. First make 20 x 9-patch blocks from 2" squares of fabric. Five contrast fabrics and four background fabric. Trim to 5" (there are spare squares)



In some kits there will be 2" squares and in other kits there are 2" strips of contrast and background fabric.

The shorter pieces, approx. 10" are sewn together, background, contrast, background. Press to the dark and cross cut into 2" sections. Make 20

The longer pieces approx. 20" are sewn together contrast, background, contrast. Make 40

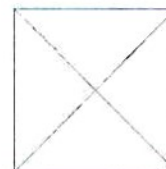
Sew together into 9-patch blocks. Make 20

There is some extra scrap in the kit if needed.

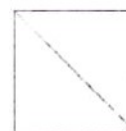
Assemble quilt in diagonal rows as shown on page 2. Trim outer edge if necessary.

Cut 16 x 5" contrast fabric squares.
Cut 49 x 5" background fabric squares.

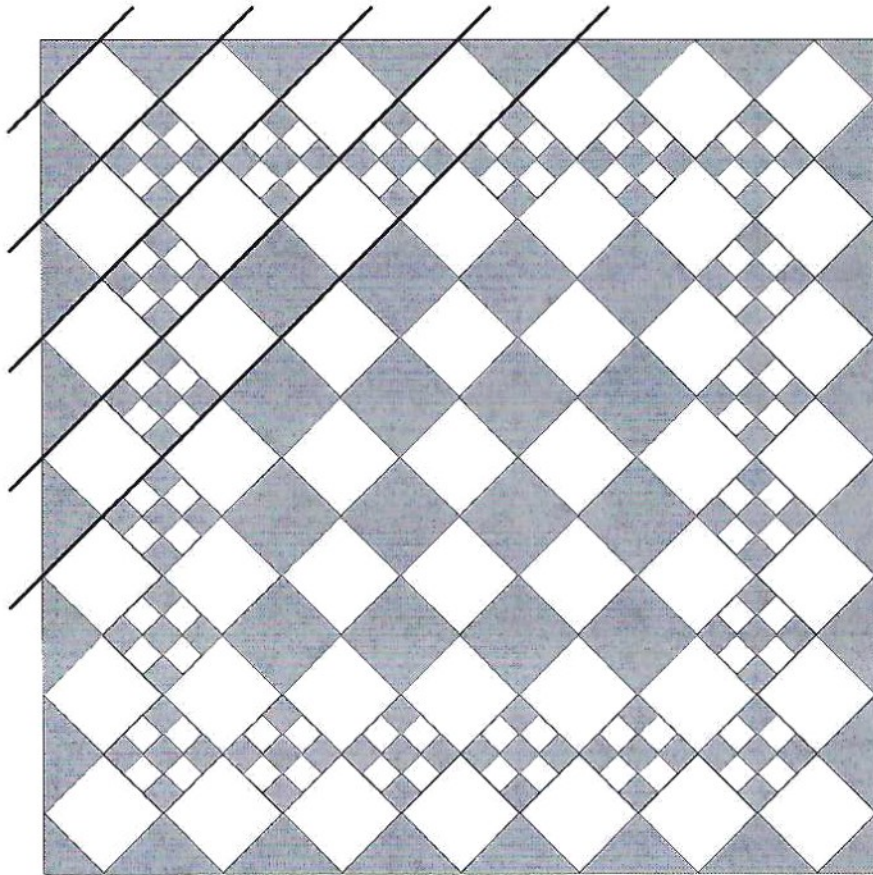
Cut 6 x 10" squares of **contrast** fabric for the setting triangles. Cut with an X to yield 24 triangles. As shown in diagram. This size will allow for the quilt to float a little at the edges.



Cut 2 x 6½" **contrast** squares for corner triangles. Cut once diagonally.

For a larger quilt a border may be added.
