CLAYTON'S STRIPES

Another Clayton's quilt, this time using stripe fabric. The block is a simple one with a plain fabric for the centre square surrounded by stripe fabrics. There are three different size blocks, $8 \times 12^{\circ}$ finished blocks, $9 \times 8^{\circ}$ finished blocks and $35 \times 4^{\circ}$ finished blocks.

12" blocks – each block cut 2 x 12½" x 4½" stripe fabric 2 x 4½" stripe squares

2 x 4½° stripe squares 1 x 4½" plain square

8" blocks - each block cut 2 x 8½" x 3½" strip fabric

2 x3¼" stripe squares 1 x 3¼" plain square


4" blocks - each block cut 2 x 4½" x 1 7/8" stripe fabric

2 x 1 7/8" stripe squares

1 x 1 7/8" plain square

The kit contains pre cut fabric including some spare fabric, at least one extra stripe for each size and some extra centre fabric.

Choose the fabric and fabric centres to make the blocks, 8 x 12" blocks, 9 x 8" blocks and 35 x 4" blocks. Sew blocks as shown in diagram below.

When all blocks are sewn together lay out the blocks following the quilt design layout, 12" blocks, 8" blocks and 4" blocks. Sew the blocks together in groups as shown by the red lines on the quilt layout diagram.
