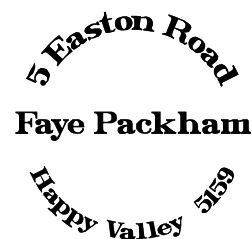




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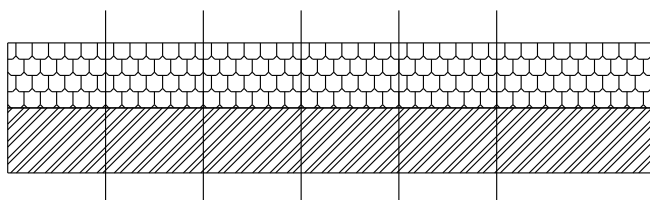
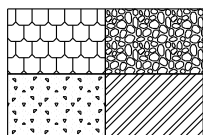
CLAYTON'S TWO BY TWO QUILT

Another fun scrap quilt to use lots of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips in many different fabrics. There is just one block, first set one way and then the other. When sewing the blocks together to make the quilt top you can start with either a horizontal block or a vertical block and alternate both across the rows and down the rows 7 x 7.

Contrast fabric The kit contains
196 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles **OR** 40 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" strips
5 3" strips for the second border

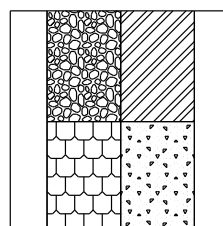
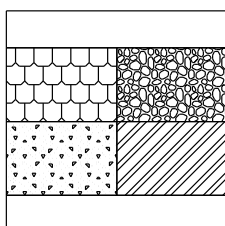
For each block make a 4-patch of contrast rectangles as in the left diagram below measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 49.

OR Sew pairs of 20" contrast strips together lengthways and cross cut at $3\frac{1}{2}$ " as in the right diagram below. Cut 98, then sew two together to make 4-patches measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 49.



Background fabric The kit contains 22 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
5 strips are for the first border.

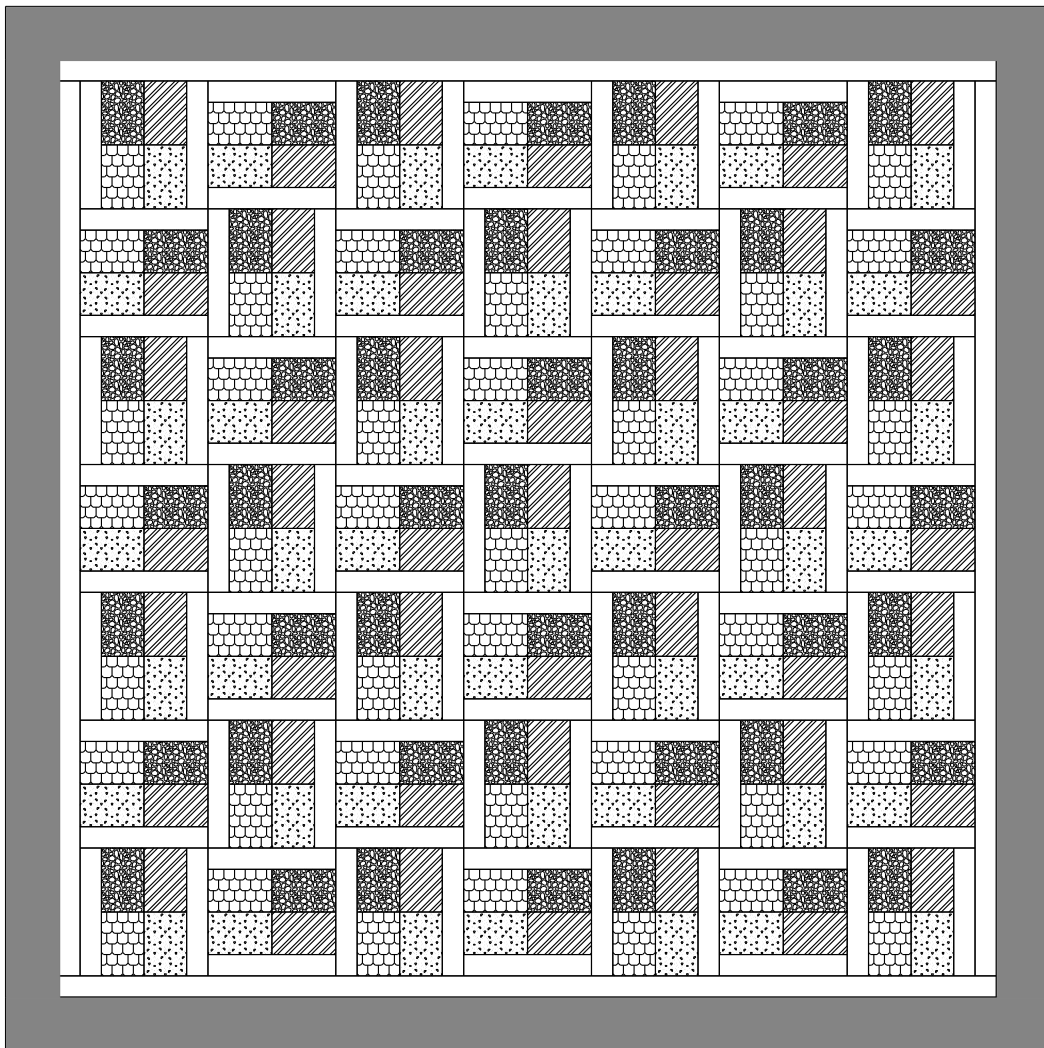
Cross cut 17 strips into 98 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Sew one rectangle strip to each side of the contrast fabric units as shown in the diagrams below. Blocks will be arranged vertically and horizontally in the finished quilt. Make 49 blocks measuring $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Arrange the blocks together as shown below.

Add 1½" background borders to each side.

Add 3" contrast borders to each side.
