



GRIEVENCE AND DISPUTE GUIDELINES

Recently when asked for the SA Quilters Grievance and Dispute policy it was noted that the policy was specifically for members and not affiliate group members. SA Quilters has now developed a Grievance and Dispute Guidelines for Groups in the hope to offer support if needed but not tell groups what they have to do. Groups can adopt the guideline as their policy if they want to. INSURANCE

(From Margaret, Insurance officer)

Non-SA Quilters individual members who are members of your group will be covered by SA Quilters Public Liability insurance with the payment of \$6 per group member at the time of Group membership renewal. If the group member is also an individual member of SA Quilters, then the \$6 is not required as they are automatically covered for insurance as part of their SA Quilters membership. However, it is important to confirm that their SA Quilters membership is current to ensure that insurance coverage.
