

MONTH TWO – BORDER TWO, PIECED 4" BLOCKS 1-5 – JUNE

BLOCK 2

This block is called *New Album 2* and will be 4" square finished. Make two of this block. I made two blocks at once, both lime green but with different lime green fabric.

Fabric requirements for Block 2

This block requires two fabrics, I chose a background and one other fabric

- A and C are background
- B and D are lime green

Cutting

- A - background - cut 4 x 1½" inch squares. These will be the corner squares
- B - lime green – cut 4 x (2½" x 1½") rectangles for the sides
- C - background – cut 2 x 1 7/8" squares, cross cut corner to corner once = 4 triangles
- D - lime green – cut one 2" square, centre square



Construction

- Lay the pieces out as shown below, left
- Stitch an A corner square to each end of a B rectangle, repeat with the other A squares and B rectangle, below centre
- Stitch a C triangle to two opposite sides of the centre D square, see below centre. Finger press to find the centre of the long side of the two C triangles and two sides of the D square. Match these up and stitch in place. Repeat with the other two C triangles and the other sides of the D square
- Attach the remaining two B green rectangles to either side of the centre C/D unit creating rows below right. Join the rows together to form the block



The two blocks are now complete and will measure 4½" square and will be 4" square finished, when sewn into the quilt.

Put aside until month 8, December
