

MONTH TWO – BORDER 2, PIECED 4" BLOCKS 1-5 – June**BLOCK 4**

This block is called *Road to Oklahoma* and will be 4" square finished. Make two of this block. I made two blocks at once, both purple, but with different purple fabrics.

Fabric requirements for Block 4

This block requires three fabrics, I chose a background and two other fabrics all purple

- A and B are dark purple with green spots
- C and D are background
- E is light purple with white fingers

Cutting

- A – dark purple with green dots – cut 2 x 1½" squares, corner squares
- B – dark purple with green dots – cut 2 x 2¼" squares, half square triangles
- C – background – cut 2 x 2¼" squares, half square triangles
- D – background – cut 6 x 1½" squares, diagonal squares
- E – light purple with fingers – cut 4 x 1½" squares, diagonal squares

Construction

- Using the B and C squares create the four x 1½" half square triangles then lay out the elements as shown below, left
- Then create rows, below right, and then sew the rows together



The two blocks are now complete and will measure 4½" square and will be 4" square finished, when sewn into the quilt.

Put aside until month 8, December
