

MONTH THREE - BORDER 2, PIECED 4" BLOCKS 6-10 - July

BLOCK 10

This block is called *Indian Star* and is 4" square finished. Make two of this block. I made two blocks at once, both purple, but with different purple fabric.

Fabric requirements for Block 10

This block requires two fabrics. I chose the background and one purple

- A is purple flowers
- B is purple flowers
- C is background
- D is background



<u>Cutting</u>

- A purple cut 6 x 1½" squares
- B purple cut 4 x 2¹/₄" squares, for half square triangles
- C background cut 4 x 2¼" squares, for half square triangles
- D background cut 2 x 1½" squares

Construction

- Using the B purple and C background squares make 8 half square triangles, trim back to 1½".
- Lay all the elements out as shown below left.
- Create rows, below right, then sew the rows together, to form the block





The two blocks are now complete and will measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square and will be 4" square finished, when sewn into the quilt.

You have now completed all the pieced blocks for border 2. Set them aside, we will put the quilt together in month 8, December.
