

## MONTH THREE – BORDER 2, PIECED 4" BLOCKS 6-10 – July

### BLOCK 6

This block is called *Arkansas Crossroads* and will be 4" square finished. Make two of this block. I made two blocks at once, both lime green, but with different lime green fabrics.

### Fabric requirements for Block 6

This block requires four fabrics, I chose the background and three lime green fabrics

- A is green with swirls
- B and C are background
- D is green check
- E is green floral



### Cutting

- A – green with swirls – cut 4 x 1½" squares, one diagonal set of squares
- B – background – cut 4 x 1½" squares
- C – background – cut 2 x 2¼" squares, half square triangles
- D – green check – cut 2 x 2¼" squares, half square triangles
- E – green floral – cut 4 x 1½" squares, second diagonal set of squares

### Construction

- Using the two C background squares and the two D green check squares create four 1½" half square triangles units.
- Lay the elements out as shown below left, create rows shown below right. Then sew the rows together to create the block



The two blocks are now complete and will measure 4½" square and will be 4" square finished, when sewn into the quilt.

Put aside until month 8, December
