

MONTH FIVE – BORDER 4, 6" APPLIQUE CORNERSTONES – September

If you haven't already done so, then this month you will need to make the four x 6" square finished applique cornerstone blocks for border 4

Using the Master Flower document and Flower 1 size 6", create the applique cornerstones



Fabric requirements for the applique blocks

You will need the background fabric and two other fabrics. I chose to continue pink in the cornerstones using two different pink fabrics

Cutting

- From the background fabric cut 4 x 6½" squares
- Following the applique instructions or using your preferred applique method create the four 6½" square applique cornerstones for border 4

Construction

- I chose to use a stripe fabric for the under petals. I thought about the placement and chose to align the stripes diagonally from corner to corner across the background block.

These blocks will measure 6½" square and will be 6" square finished, when sewn into the quilt.

Put aside until month 8, December.
