

## MONTH FIVE – BORDER 4, PIECED 6" BLOCKS 5-8 – September

### BLOCK 7

This block is called *Water Wheel* and will be 6" square finished. Make two of this block. I made both blocks at once, both aqua, but with different aqua fabrics.

### Fabric requirements for this block

This block requires four fabrics, I chose the background and three aqua fabrics

- A and E are aqua floral
- B is aqua spot
- C is background
- D is aqua check

### Cutting

- A - aqua floral – cut 8 x 1½" squares, for four patch blocks
- B – aqua spot – cut 8 x 1½" squares, for four patch blocks
- C – background – cut 2 x 3¾" squares, for half square triangles
- D – aqua check – cut 2 x 3¾" squares, for half square triangles
- E – aqua floral – cut 1 x 2½" square, centre square

### Construction

- Using one C background and one D aqua check square create half square triangles, trim to 2½" square. Repeat with the second C and D squares = four 2½" half square triangles
- Lay the elements out as shown below, left
- Using the A aqua floral and B aqua spot 1½" squares create four, 4 patch 2½" blocks as shown centre
- Create rows, then the block



The two blocks are now complete and will measure 6½" square and will be 6" square finished, when sewn into the quilt. Put aside until month 8, December.
