

MONTH FIVE – BORDER 5 – September

Fabric requirements for Border 5

This border is cut 2½” and will be 2” finished, when sewn into the quilt

- If you haven’t already done so then this month you will need to make the four x 2” finished square applique cornerstones
- You will need background fabric and one other fabric for the cornerstones. I chose pink again, the same fabric as I had used in border 1
- Using the Master Flower document and Flower 1 size 2”, create the applique cornerstones
- 35cm width of fabric for the “ric rac” stripe border



Cutting

- From the background fabric cut 4 x 2½” squares for the cornerstones
- From the ric rac stripe fabric cut 5 x 2½” width of fabric strips. From these construct 4 x (44½” x 2½”) border pieces

Construction

- Create the 4 x 2½” square cornerstone blocks as per your choice, above left
- Add a cornerstone to both ends of TWO of the ric rac border pieces, press seams toward the border fabric, photo above right. These two will now measure 48½”, the other two will still measure 44½”.

Once the borders are complete set them aside, we will put the quilt together in month 8, December.
