Wendy Williams is an internationally renowned quilter and tutor. She has been quilting for 25 years and teaches many techniques in her classes. She has numerous awards and her first book was published in the United States in 2014, titled *Wild Blooms and Colorful Creatures*.

Wow! Look at these gorgeous 'pod' bags, which can have so many different uses.

A combination of fabrics, threads and embellishments can be applied to these. What a fun way to spend a day, while learning new techniques.

Wendy will demonstrate her methods of appliqué and encourage you to create individual 'pods'. These items can incorporate fabrics from your stash. Wendy favours wool felt appliqué, because it leaves a clean edge when cut, but a variety of fabrics can be used. Embellishing with a range of threads and stitches adds a '3D' feel to the 'pods'.

Wendy will demonstrate ways to complete the pods with a professional finish.
