

MONTH SIX – BORDER 6, 8" APPLIQUE BLOCKS - FLOWERS 2 AND 3 – October**FLOWER 2**

These blocks are cut 8½" square and will be 8" square finished, when sewn into the quilt.

Using the Master Flower pattern make 8 x Flower 2 applique blocks.

Border 6 requires 1.60m of background fabric. Cut 7 x 8½" width of fabric strips. Cross cut into 28 x 8½" squares. These will be enough for all applique blocks in the border, plus cornerstones. Don't forget if you are doing needle turn applique cut the blocks 1" bigger and cut back to size once the applique is complete.

Fabric requirements for this block

- Flower 2 x 8 blocks = 16 different purple fabrics
- 8 x 8½" background squares from those detailed above

**Construction**

- Using the Master Flower applique pattern Flower 2 and your preferred method of applique create 8 x Flower 2 applique blocks.

Set aside until month 8, December.
